

Call for Poster Abstracts

2018 AAHRPP Conference:

“Summitting New Heights in the Mile-High City: Early Experiences, Strategies, and Solutions”

AAHRPP is now accepting abstracts from accredited organizations for poster presentations at the 2018 Annual AAHRPP Conference which will be held April 20-22 in Denver, Colorado.

This call for abstracts is focused on innovative practices for Human Research Protections Programs (HRPP) related to the theme of the conference – “*Summitting New Heights in the Mile-High City: Early Experiences, Strategies, and Solutions*”. The innovative practice may relate to any aspect of human research protection, but preference will be given to topics related to the themes of the conference, such as successful strategies for implementing the new Common Rule, sharing experiences and strategies for transitioning to the new regulatory environment, implementing broad consent, and interpreting the reasonable person standard for informed consent. The Poster Session will provide presenting authors a forum to showcase their innovative ideas and the opportunity for participants to review the information and talk with presenters. All presenters are asked to include any related metrics that they use such as forms, checklists, and templates.

The deadline for submitting an abstract is **February 2, 2018 at 5:00 p.m. ET**.

Authors will be notified by **February 9, 2018** if their abstract is accepted for presentation, and instructions for preparing the poster will be provided at that time.

Presenters are required to register and pay the registration fee.

To submit an abstract for consideration, send the abstract in a Word (.doc) format to accredit@ahrpp.org. In the subject line, type “Poster Abstract for 2018 Annual Conference”.
